# Raffle Quilt 2018 Stars, Geese & Piano Keys Needed

Summer is almost over and we need to be stitching "full force" on our 2018 Raffle Quilt. The quilt will consist of 3 different paper pieced 6 ½" square blocks. The blocks are a Carol Doak Mariner's Star, Flying Geese and an easy Piano Key for the border. Members have been asked to contribute bright batiks from their stash. Background fabric is silver Kona cotton. Many cuts of the silver were handed out at the spring meetings. Please make sure you find your piece and use it up. Here is a mock up of the squares we have so far:



We obviously need a lot more to make this an awesome full sized quilt. Please bring any finished blocks to the September 11<sup>th</sup> meeting. If you cannot attend, either send them along with a friend or snail mail them to:

A few pointers on making paper pieced 6 ½" squares:

- Reduce your stitch length to appox. 1.75.
- No need to back stitch.
- Leave papers on the back.
- The Piano Keys can be made without paper by stitching 3 (2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together. We need lots of piano keys for the border.
- If you have any extra 6 ½" bright batik squares to contribute they can be added.

Thank you for all your contributions. It takes the entire Guild membership to make this a great quilt.
